

Introduction

- The Red Express was the Santa Fe's first luxury train
- It ran between Chicago and St. Louis over
- Chicago, Santa Fe & California (controlled and operated by the Santa Fe)
- Toledo, Peoria & Western
- Jacksonville Southeastern Line (the Chicago, Peoria & St. Louis)
- Operated from December 21, 1890, to August 10, 1893
- ☐ The train, though short-lived, was famous for its elegant accommodations and superlative service
- It was the last expression of the Santa Fe's long-held dream to make St. Louis an integral part of its system


























THE RED EXPRESS St. Charles Reclining Coach Car









THE RED EXPRESS 1893 Santa Fe System Map


